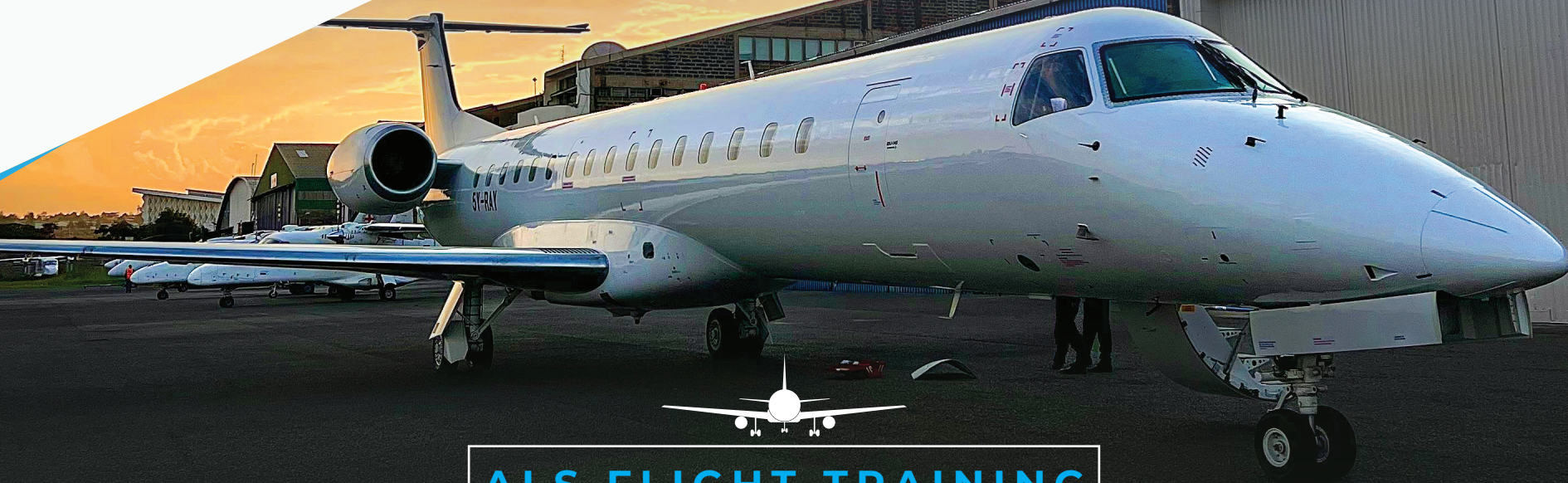

This potentially opens the door to further advancement within ALS onto our larger aircraft types such as the Beechcraft 1900, DeHavilland Dash 8 and Embraer 145. There is currently no flying school in the region that offers this opportunity.
- The trainer aircraft used by ALS Flight Training are equipped with state-of-the-art avionics that introduce the students to the modern-technology cockpits to be found in modern aircraft operated, not only by ALS itself, but industry-wide. No other flying school in the region currently offers this.
- Kenyan students will have the opportunity to train within Kenya, rather than travelling overseas. This not only inducts the students into the Kenyan aviation sphere from the start but saves the expense of living abroad and having to convert their foreign licenses, once obtained, to Kenyan licenses – a time consuming and costly process.
